

- While dancers may maintain affiliation with other troupes and are free to teach on their own, *recruiting students away from the founder's classes is prohibited because funding for the organization comes primarily from these classes*; therefore, violators will have their membership terminated.
- Dancers must adhere to rules of professionalism, which include not partaking of intoxicants before or during a performance. Any dancers acting drunk and disorderly will have their membership terminated.
- Troupe members should act respectfully toward one another and refrain from any prejudiced remarks. Acting disrespectfully to other members of the troupe or any volunteers affiliated with The Champagne Girls will result in termination of membership.
- Dancers, being aware of their own health and physical condition, are voluntarily participating in the “Motion With A Mission” Charity Benefit Shows and nursing home shows or corporate parties given by Sherri Van Houten and The Champagne Girls Non-Profit Organization. Having said knowledge, dancers hereby release Sherri Van Houten, of the Champagne Girls, a NJ Non-Profit Organization, from liability for accidental injury, illness, which may incur as a result of participating in said Charity Benefit Show and hereby assume all risks connected therewith and consent to participate in said program.
