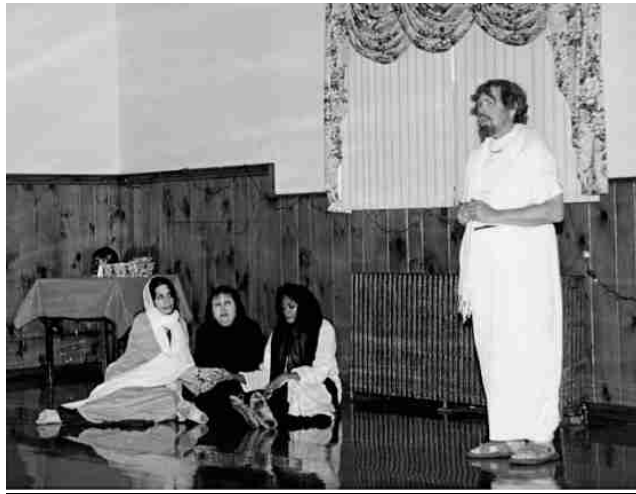

The Champagne Girls have been interviewed and featured on Cable TV: On Morris County's Neighborhood Journal and on Sussex County's Skylands Weekly. In 2010, they also appeared on the Red Cross Telethon in East Stroudsburg, PA. They have been featured in articles in the Star Ledger, NJ Herald, and Advertiser South, Suburban Trends, Ames News, and interviewed for Latin Jubilee Radio (Warwick, NY) and Home-Grown Radio, in Sussex County. From the inception of the organization in 2004, they have donated over \$17,000 to charities, which include CARE, Eva's Village (a homeless shelter in Paterson), Ginnie's House (Advocacy Center for abused children), the American Red Cross, International Rescue Committee, Doctors Without Borders, numerous battered women's shelters, and The Andrea Rizzo Foundation to assist children with cancer.
